Bob & Suzanne's Wind Rider Equestrian Challenge™, presented by Bob Jeffreys & Suzanne Sheppard is open to riders 12 years or older from all disciplines including western, dressage, hunter/jumpers, trail riders, natural horsemen, gaited horse riders and more. In the initial rounds on Thursday, Friday and Saturday, up to 18 riders each day will compete with their own horses on a course that includes challenges drawn from gymkhana, dressage, reining patterns, jousting, gaited horse events, trail obstacles, cavalletti patterns, hunter pace courses, etc. The cross disciplinary course will consist of a pattern including (but not limited to) some of the following elements: **circles cantered on the correct lead with speed control (gaited breeds should be able to canter), a 2 foot jump, trotting or gaiting while balancing an object in one hand, backing through and around barrels, sidepassing, ground poles, balanced halts, turn on the haunches or turnarounds, leg yielding, open/close a gate, and a ring joust.** Judges will award points based on accuracy, the horse's willingness, good horsemanship and equitation. If you and your horse can perform these maneuvers and you want to show off your teamwork in front of an audience, then you are great candidates for participation! At the end of each preliminary round day the qualifying finalist will be announced.

For the final challenge on Sunday, the single top scoring participant from each preliminary round will rank as one of only three finalists and will be paired randomly with one of the mystery star clinicians!

On Saturday evening the three Wind Rider finalists will draw straws to be paired with one of the three star clinicians and compete for the title of "Wind Rider Champion" in the final rounds on Sunday. Only the competitor will be scored: the clinician is there to help you show your best with your horse and therefore the clinician's performance is not scored. **The final round will include a new challenge course and a 2-5 minute freestyle by each team! Here's your once in a lifetime chance to ride with the stars!**

The final challenge course to all participants, including clinicians, will be posted on Saturday evening. In the finals, judges will select the Wind Rider Grand Champion, Wind Rider Reserve Champion and Wind Rider Runner Up based on criteria provided by Bob Jeffreys and Suzanne Sheppard.

With a Masters Degree in Education, a black sash in T'ai Chi and more than 20 years of teaching experience, she is able to teach complex equitation concepts in a humorous, creative and down to earth style, which empowers horses and riders to fulfill their individual and combined potential.

Bob and Suzanne's unique horse training and teaching talents come together in their **Two as One Horsemanship™**, striking a perfect balance between the English and Western riding disciplines in a way that inspires equine enthusiasts worldwide. Join them online, at equine expos across North America and in their Two as One Clinics, Horsemanship Education Courses and ProTrack™ Horse Trainer Certification Program. They have also been invited to present clinics at the 2010 Alltech EI World Equestrian Games in Lexington, KY!

Objectives and judging

Each rider will be given a time limit in which to complete the entire course; it will be up to each rider to decide how much time to devote to each specific challenge. Falling off safety issues (i.e. repeated rearing) or failure to complete the course within the allowed timeframe will result in disqualification. Points will be awarded for each challenge in the course on a scale of 0 to 5, with 0 being the lowest and 5 being the highest, based on the combined performance of horse and rider. Judging will be based on accuracy, horse's attitude, good horsemanship and excellence in equitation.

Illegal equipment

Participants will be disqualified for use of draw reins or mechanical hackamores. All other well-fitting tack is acceptable.

How to apply:

Bob & Suzanne's Wind Rider Equestrian Challenge™ is open to all riders 12 years of age or older and horses of all breeds. Each horse/rider team will compete against all others in the initial rounds; no classes or divisions are made by gender, age, breed, etc. Individual riders may compete with more than one horse, but a separate entry application and fee must be submitted for each horse they wish to use in the competition. Applications must be received by February 17, 2010, and will be reviewed by Bob Jeffreys & Suzanne Sheppard, who will consider applications until up to 51 participants have been confirmed. Entry/stall fees of accepted participants will not be refundable. ***Entry/stall fees are now reduced to \$175: Tack stalls are not included in the \$175 fee; a limited number are available on a first come, first serve basis for an additional \$125. If you are confirmed as part of a breed demo or the stallion avenue and already have a stall paid for by your organization then your fee is only \$125;*** no additional stall will be provided. Please indicate below which breed/name or stallion you are demonstrating and the name of your contact person so we may confirm.

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Selected applicants will be notified by telephone; all others will have entry fee checks returned and will be notified by mail. Entry applications are due by February 17, 2010; only applications complete with entry forms, signed waivers and entry/stall fees will be considered. A fee of \$45 will be charged for all returned checks. All horses must be brought to the PA Horse World Expo at the Farm Show Complex in Harrisburg, PA free of illness and infectious disease and must have appropriate health paperwork as described below.

Additional information about competing in *Bob & Suzanne's Wind Rider Equestrian Challenge*

Applicants who are accepted will be provided with one stall which will be available beginning Wednesday, February 24; check in is from 9am –7pm. Because entry fees will not be refunded under any circumstances, we strongly suggest arriving as early as possible within the given timeframes. All participants must be checked by 8pm of the evening prior to their preliminary round ride. All Wind Rider Challenge participants are required to house their horses on site due to the likelihood of early start times of the competition and difficulty with traffic in the mornings of the show. Be sure to allow extra time to gain access to the Farm Show Complex in the morning to avoid missing your time of go due to traffic!

Documents required at the barn check in are an original Certificate for negative Coggins current within one-year of the event for all horses, and health certificates current within 30-days of the final day of the event if the horse is stabled outside of PA. Order of go and challenge pattern will be posted in the stable area at the check in desk on Wednesday after 5pm. Scheduled days for each round of competition are as follows: The initial challenge rounds will be held on Thursday Feb. 25, Friday, Feb. 26 and Saturday, Feb 27. The top scoring participant on each day will earn a place in the final championship round on Sunday, February 28. Finalists will receive the championship challenge pattern on Saturday evening. Exact times will be determined by expo management and all accepted participants will be informed accordingly.

Bob & Suzanne's Wind Rider Equestrian Challenge™ at the PA Horse World Expo will be held at the Farm Show Complex in Harrisburg, PA. This competition will offer a unique, challenging opportunity to showcase the best in cross-disciplinary horsemanship while competing for the chance to ride with some star clinicians. Please note that applicants must be aware that the challenge will be held in a large arena with a large numbers of spectators. There will not be an opportunity to practice or acclimate your horse to the arena in which the Challenge is taking place; if you and /or your horse cannot function safely and with good horsemanship in such an environment, we suggest that you not apply.

I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and performing in equine events involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering or death ("Harm").

If you wish to participate with more than one horse, then you must complete a separate application for each horse and pay the \$225 fee for each horse (\$175 per horse if #2 above applies to you). A limited number of tack stalls may be available on a first come, first serve basis for an additional \$150

4. Please do not send money orders. Checks will be returned to applicants who are not selected. Selected applicants will be notified by phone: all others will be notified by mail. Applications will be accepted until the maximum of 51 participants have been accepted or until Feb. 17, whichever comes first.

**Important information for your participation in the
Pennsylvania Horse World Expo
Guidelines for Stabling, Parking and Participating in Horse Related Activities**

Stall Information

1. Anyone wishing to use a stall during Horse World Expo must complete the enclosed Stall Reservation form in its entirety.
 - a. **One form per horse** must be completed and a copy of this form will be placed on your assigned stall by our staff before your arrival.
 - b. The cost of these stalls is included with your Challenge entry fee and is for the weekend.
 - c. A completed Stall Reservation Form must be mailed in order to reserve a stall(s).
 - d. There are NO REFUNDS for unused stalls.
2. You may bring your own bedding to the show, or you may pre-order straw on the attached Stall Reservation Form. If you are planning on purchasing straw, this must be done IN ADVANCE via the Stall Reservation Form. The cost of straw is \$7.00 per bale if pre-ordered and \$8.00 per bale if purchased at the show.
3. You may order an additional stall at the cost of \$125 for use as a tack stall, but this must be done in advance and must be paid for in advance; availability, if any, is limited. There are no refunds for unused stalls, however refund will be processed if a tack stall is not available. The fee for a tack stall must be remitted with your stall reservation form.
4. All Horse World Expo forms and paperwork, including Stall Reservation Forms, must be received with entry applications by mail along with Coggins, and if required, a Health Certificate **no later than February 10, 2010**. All paperwork will then be transferred by Wind Rider Challenge staff to Horse World Expo staff.
5. Horses must be placed in the stalls designated for that horse. If a change must be made, the Horse World Expo staff member located in the barns must be notified before the move is made.
6. Please keep in mind that there will be stallions housed in the barns with the demonstration horses. We will do what we can to accommodate mares by housing them away from the stallions, but please be aware that this may require us to separate them from the rest of your group.

Horse health requirements

1. All horses attending Horse World Expo must be current on all vaccinations.
2. A copy of a negative Coggins, current with-in one year of March 1, 2010, must accompany the Stall Reservation Form for all horses – **no stall reservations** will be made without Coggins.
3. Horse World Expo staff will be comparing Coggins to the horses in stalls – for this reason DO NOT swap horses – please be sure to put your horse in the correct stall. Any horse not matching the Coggins given may be asked to leave the grounds immediately.
4. A Health Certificate is required for all horses coming to the show and stabled outside of Pennsylvania. A copy of the health certificate, current within 30 days of March 1, 2010, must be included with your entry application for all horses stabled outside of Pennsylvania.
5. **NO** horse will be allowed to enter the stables or the show without the proper health papers as described above and no stalls will be assigned without these forms.
6. Please do not send originals, as they cannot be returned to you.
7. **ABSOLUTELY no paperwork will be accepted at the show – all forms MUST be received by Feb. 10, 2010. Faxed copies will NOT be accepted – NO stalls will be assigned until all forms, required paperwork and payments are received.**

*****Details about order of go, etc will be addressed to those applicants who are accepted. Preliminary rounds will be held on Thurs, Fri & Sat. Each Challenger will ride on one of those days, and only the single top point earner each day will ride in the finals on Sunday. ******

Check-in Procedures - General

1. When you arrive at the show site, please check in and get your stall assignment at the barns. A Horse World Expo staff member will be available Wednesday 9-8, Thursday 9-8, Friday 9-8, Saturday 9-8, Sun. 9-5 in the barns to assist you.
2. Staff will only be available during the hours listed above – please plan accordingly. No horses may arrive outside of the hours listed above – **NO EXCEPTIONS**.
3. Do not unload your horses until you have received your stall assignment. For the safety of all horses attending the Expo, health paperwork must be verified before you may unload your horse.
4. No horses may arrive at the Farm Show Complex before Wednesday, February 24 at 9:00am.
5. All horses must be off of the Farm Show Complex grounds by 11:00am Monday, March 1, 2010.

Parking information

1. All horse trailers **MUST** be parked in designated areas only – see attached parking map. **NO** vehicles or trailers may be parked in the blacktop parking area used by the public during the show. Please use the Exhibitor Parking areas. Please remember that the main parking areas must be reserved for show attendees. These public parking areas are not for use by exhibitors.
2. Illegally parked trailers may be ticketed, towed or become blocked by other vehicles. All fines incurred by trailers parked illegally are the responsibility of the trailer owner.
3. At no time should trailers be stopped to load and unload horses in the traveled portion of the road or in designated fire lanes. **NO EXCEPTIONS**.
4. No horse trailers or pick-up trucks can be listed “For Sale” while parked on the Farm Show Complex Property. This is done to protect vendors exhibiting in Horse World Expo and is strictly enforced.
5. A \$8 per day parking fee is charged by the Farm Show Complex, this fee applies to show days only (Thu-Sun). You may pay this fee to the facility as you come and go each day, or you may purchase a parking pass in the barns when you arrive for each day that you will be driving in. The fee applies to each separate vehicle, but an attached truck/trailer only pays a single \$8 fee. There is no fee for leaving your vehicle parked on the grounds.

Rider Information

1. All individuals riding or handling horses must sign the enclosed Release Form. **UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES** should anyone be allowed to handle or ride a horse unless they have signed and submitted the release form.
2. Riders competing in The Wind Rider Challenge will be allowed into the show at no charge **only** on the day (s) that they are to ride.
 - a. Indicate who the riders will be on the Horse World Expo Release Form as this will be used to develop a list to admit these riders into the show.
 - b. **Anyone not listed as a rider on the Release will be required to purchase a full price ticket for the show.**
 - c. Only one rider per horse will be admitted at no charge **on the day(s) they are competing only** – we will use the horse's Coggins and stall reservation forms to determine how many riders will be allowed into the show. If you choose to enter the Expo on days that you are not scheduled to ride, you may purchase an admission ticket in the lobby of the Farm Show Complex during regular Expo hours.
3. Riders for The Wind Rider Challenge should check in at the barns on the day they are scheduled to ride and have their hand stamped, this will enable them to come and go during the show day. Badges will not be issued. Show admission is for the day you are performing only, you may purchase an admission ticket if you choose to attend the Expo on other days.
4. Anyone whose name is not on the Rider List as indicated in item 2 above or whose name is not on the exhibitor badge list, will be charged the daily admission fee to the show (adults \$12.00, ages 7-12 \$6.00). Anyone with horses stabled in the Farm Show Complex barn will have access to them during the entire show. Show admission is not required to access the barn area.

5. Special barn badges will be issued to all people needing access to the barns. Please make sure that everyone in your group that needs access to your horse(s) signs the enclosed release form and gets a barn badge. You can pick these up in the barn. This is being done to assure the safety of your horses and the general public. No one from the general public will be admitted to the barns during the show. These barn badges are for admittance to the barns only – they will not admit anyone to the Expo.
6. To gain admittance to the Expo – each rider must check-in and have their hand stamped on a daily basis, admission is only good on the day you are to ride. Riders may check-in at the barns.

Wind Rider Challenge riders must be on the show grounds at least two hours prior to the demonstration in which you will participate.

General Expo Guidelines

1. For your safety, the safety of your horses and the safety of the general public, show security is on site at all times during the show. No horses or riders will be allowed in the building or rings before the show opens or after it closes **NO EXCEPTIONS**.
2. No one will be permitted to bring their horses into the arenas for practice during show hours. Events are scheduled in our arenas at all times during show hours. Immediately before and after the show each day, rings may be closed for maintenance. If you are asked to leave an arena by show or facility staff, please do so immediately.
3. Access to barns is available 24 hours per day during the show for all horse owners. Only those with official barn badges will be admitted into the barns. Please be sure to pick up a barn badge when you arrive with your horses
4. Individuals or Groups whose members ignore requests from or who are abusive to any Horse World Expo or Farm Show Complex employee may be asked to leave the facility and forfeit all monies paid. Please make sure all members of your group are aware of the guidelines outlined in this package. Individuals or organizations violating this provision may also lose the privilege of participating in future Horse World Expos.
5. Copies of these guidelines should be given to all members of your organization who are bringing horses, trailers or working with your horses during the Expo.

We value your participation; these guidelines are in place to make Horse World Expo an enjoyable and positive experience for all who attend.

Enclosed is a **Stall Reservation** form and **Release** for your use, please make copies as needed. These forms, as well as the copy of your horse's **Coggins** and all **stall and straw payments** due, must be included with your entry form and received **by Feb. 17, 2010**. **The health certificate, if applicable, may be mailed separately, but must be received by Feb. 18**. **Please note: any horse stabled outside of PA will be turned away if health certificate is not present, no exceptions and no refund**. Stall assignments will not be made if these items are not received by these deadlines. **The required paperwork will not be accepted after these deadlines**. We have enclosed a "Check List" to help you keep track of necessary paperwork; we hope that you find this check list helpful.
